# 2020 Reciprocals Information

#### Newmarket -

Please advise your members to park in the free car park which is located closer to our Free Pass Office at the Premier Entrance 2. This is the office they will need to go into to show their York badge. They will be issued with an entry ticket for entry. If they can be wearing their York badge this will gain them entry into our Premier Enclosure facilities. No access to annual badge holder facilities due to space restrictions.

We operate a smart dress code in our Premier Enclosure:

No trainers, t-shirts, sportswear, fancy dress or extreme attire is permitted. Dark denim ONLY.

#### Goodwood -

Your members will have access to our Members' Enclosure, the Richmond Enclosure.

We do have a dress code in the Richmond Enclosure, we regret that anyone deemed to be dressed inappropriately will not be admitted to the Richmond Enclosure.

**All** – Jeans, shorts, trainers and fancy dress are not permitted into the Richmond Enclosure.

**Gentlemen** – Required to wear jackets and wither a tie, cravat or polo neck sweater at all race meetings.

**Ladies** — Should dress smartly. High heels are not recommended due to the terrain and use of decking.

**Children** – Must be dressed smartly. Boys aged 16+ are required to follow the dress code for gentlemen. Boys under 16 are kindly requested to wear a collared shirt.

**Annual Members' Bar –** Strictly Goodwood Metal Badge holders only.

Parking is free in No 8 car park, your members will just need to show their badge or card to gain entry.

#### Ascot -

Reciprocal visitors visiting Ascot in 2020 can park free of charge with their relevant car park label in either car park 1 or car park 2 (whichever is available). Once parked proceed to one of our Ticket Offices to collect an entry ticket on production of their relevant metal badge, this ticket will give admission into the racecourse, once inside the racecourse please wear your racecourses relevant metal badge which will allow access to the King Edward VII Enclosure (Level 4).

## Doncaster -

Your Annual members will be able to gain access to our County stand which includes access to the Winning Post and the Parade Ring, the Pre-Parade Ring & Saddling Boxes and access to the ground, 1st and 2nd floors of our main stand. Guests will also be able to go over to the Champagne Lawn which is home to The Old Weighing Room Restaurant which will be open on most fixtures.

Car parking here at Doncaster is available in car park A which is located directly opposite the course and priced at £5 per vehicle. Alternately we have carpark C available, which is free of charge but is a slight walk. All car parks are sign posted from surrounding roads.

## Cheltenham -

Your members will have access to the Club and Tattersalls enclosures.

Unfortunately we are unable to offer access to the member's facilities.

Parking is free of charge and is located in the Green parking zone. Please follow the Green route when approaching the course.
