Organisation: Age UK

Organisation: Antibiotic Research UK

ANTRUK tackles the growing global threat of antibiotic resistant infections, driving forward innovative solutions, improving the lives of patients and raising awareness.



Sweet William (IRE)

Organisation: Barnsley Hospice

Barnsley Hospice is a provider of palliative and end of life care services.



Enemy (GB)

Organisation: Calderdale Smartmove

Calderdale Smartmove, based in Halifax support homeless and vulnerably housed people.



Saratoga Gold (GB)

Organisation: Friends of Kirkham Henry Performing Arts CIC

They are a Community Interest Company in Malton, offering a performing arts school in Ryedale that works across the generations and with disability groups.



Wickywickywheels (IRE)

Organisation: Homeless Street Angels

The team go out every Thursday night around Leeds city centre to hand out over 100 hot meals as well as essential such as warm clothes, toiletries, & sleeping bags. They also have a foodbank benefiting 400 families.



Tashkhan (IRE)

Organisation: Kingfisher Café

The venue supports the homeless in Bridlington, with both hot meals and practical essentials.





Berkshire Rocco (FR)

Organisation: Library of Things

It is a library but for things people use infrequently and so normally have to buy. It has so far saved people over £200k since it opened and 200 tonnes of carbon dioxide from going into the atmosphere by using items to their full potential.



Adjuvant (IRE)

Organisation: Looking Back CIC

A network of sporting & social reminiscence groups for sufferers of memory loss ilnesses and those who are socially isolated, Clubs exist in the most disadvantaged areas; working with Dewsbury Rams, Batley Bulldogs, Huddersfield Giants and Hull KR.



Cemhaan (GB)

Organisation: Menfulness

Offer peer support and social connection - a community to manage mental health and access free counselling.



Scampi (GB)

Organisation: Open Country

A Yorkshire charity that enables people living with disabilities or ill-mental health to access and enjoy the great outdoors.



Caius Chorister (FR)

Organisation: Proud 'N' Diverse

Leeds based, providing support and guidance to LGBTQI+ community, on matters of housing to social welfare and education.



Live Your Dream (IRE)

Organisation: Streetangels York

Volunteers patrol York city centre on Friday & Saturday evenings, helping with flip flops, directions, a friendly chat, or to get them home safely.



Sunchart (GB)



Provide, train and support specialist assistance dogs to increase the independence and quality of life for those affected by autism, epilepsy and physical disability.



HMS President (IRE)



A newly formed Community Interest Company, to provide professional, therapeutic support to women and their partners who have suffered miscarriage, stillbirth, neonatal death, or birth trauma.



Yashin (IRE)

Organisation: The Clothing Bank

A clothing bank community that recycle pre-loved clothing to make seven days' worth of clothing packs. These are given out to people who are struggling to clothe themselves after everyday expenses.



Ocean Wind (GB)

Organisation: The Crafty Creatives – Cancer Support Group

A group that provides free weekly art/craft sessions for those affected or recovering from cancer



Scriptwriter (IRE)

Organisation: The Partially Sighted Society

The Society help people with visual impairments rebuild their lives following their sight loss diagnosis.



Euchen Glen (GB)

Organisation: Working Carers Champions

A Community Interest Company (CIC) which works with unpaid working carers to help them feel valued, visible and supported.



Real Dream (IRE)

Organisation: York, Ryedale & District Multiple Sclerosis Group

The Group supports those with MS as well as their family and friends.



Get Shirty (IRE)

Organisation: Poppleton Community Trust

Provides facilities for local community groups to help the elderly, vulnerable and combat isolation. It also houses sporting groups to assist in positive mental health and fitness.



Absurde (FR)

Organisation: Sheffield Voices

The learning disability arm of Disability Sheffield - a self-advocacy group that supports people to have a say about issues that affect them.
